JUDIASM

Suicide is prohibited as well as any way to hasten death due to how it deprives one of possibilities to do good deeds. It also destroys the soul given by God. A death can only be ruled a suicide by a rabbi per Jewish tradition. The family still receives support, but there is no eulogy and the person is not buried with 6 feet of another Jew (Leach, 2006)



ISLAM

Those that die by suicide reside in hell. Suicide is the second worse sin (next to the denial of Allah). Having ideation is considered forbidden due to how it shows one's lack of devotion.
